
Each month we will offer news, upcoming events, artists' work, and other information for you.





If you start with an 8 10 x 11 sheet of paper, the starting square will be 8 10 inches on a side.


By gently fickling back the top of the triangle (Restration S), it becomes the guide for the next two loos.

The final piece with fit mostly into an A4 (4 1.5 x 5 1.7 inert) envelope. The decorative "demond" coaning in the trust part also be used to tuck in something clever. Se sure to give the parts shaded crange in the drawing.


