

- 3. All displayed work must be for sale. Gallery will collect 25% commission on all sales.
- All art entered will be subject to review by a gallery committee, not judged for merit but for
  professionalism in display. Multiple entries by a single member are acceptable.

Alcohol dropped into watercolor washes, bruising the paper, splatter technique and different types of resists were just a few of the techniques we learned. One of the funnest lessons was a very concentrate walnut ink background that you draw in with water and lift the color out. In the end all the techniques were stitched together in a book making it a guick and easy personal reference of the workshop.
